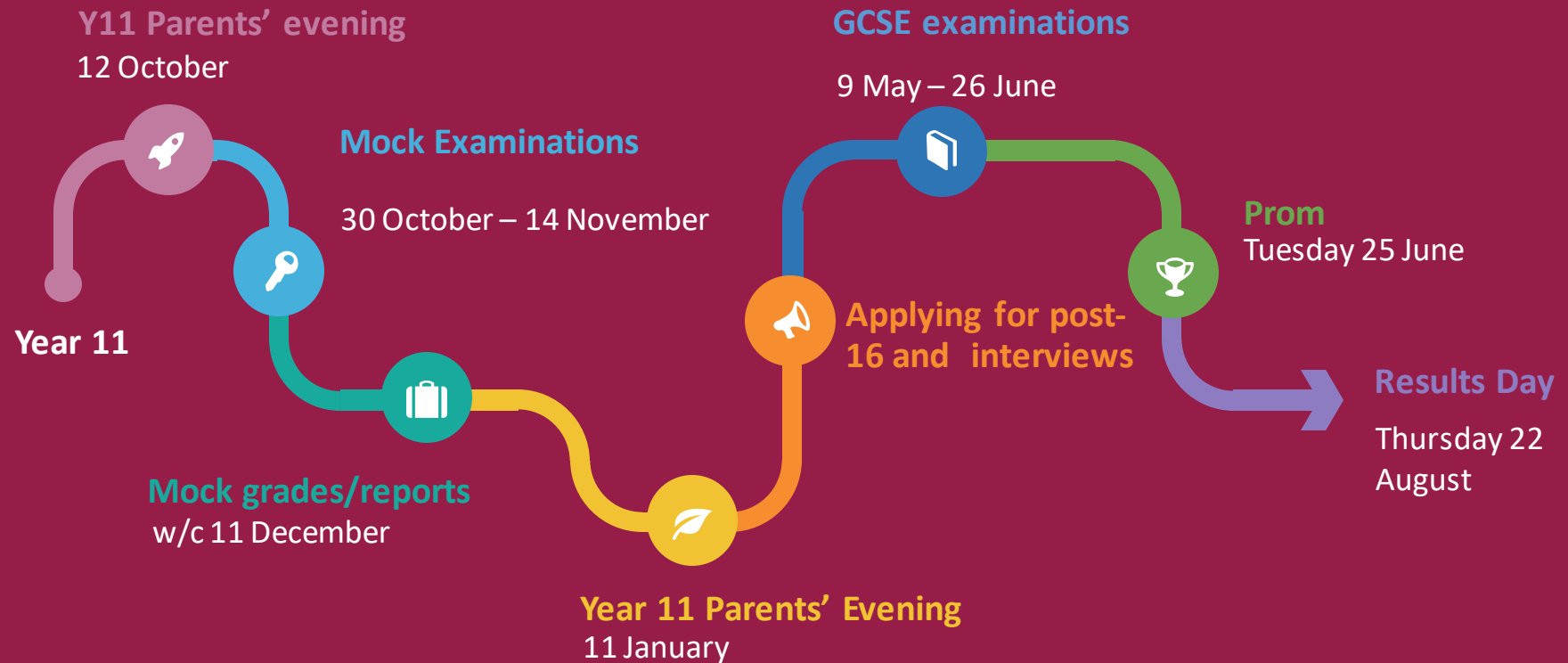

## Filtering and Monitoring



Whilst in the classroom, students are monitored when on devices by the class teacher and/or Teaching assistant



We also have constant vigilance of internet use via a specialist monitoring platform.



Staff are alerted if anything is accessed that shouldn't be



Conversations are then had with students and parents where needed.

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# Transition to Post 16

## Which Qualifications?

### ➤ A levels

- Choose three or four subjects for a personalised combination
- Exam based assessment

### ➤ BTEC or other vocational qualifications

- Study different aspects of one vocational area
- Mainly coursework-based assessment
- Level 3 courses are the equivalent of three A levels

### ➤ A levels & vocational qualifications

- Combine two A levels and one vocational course

### ➤ Apprenticeships

- A combination of work and study
- Typically, four days work with one day at college
- Earn as you learn

### ➤ T-Levels

- Launched in 2020 in collaboration with employers to meet needs of industry
- Equivalent to 3 A levels
- 80% in classroom, 20% in workplace

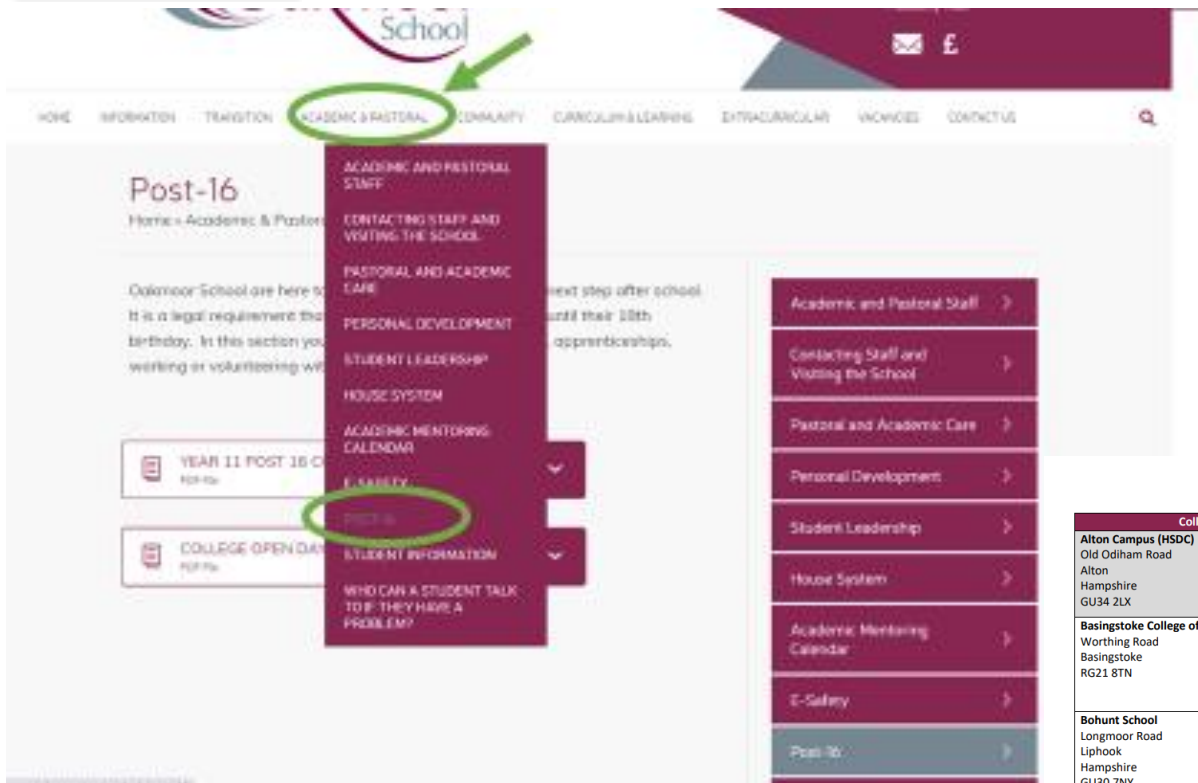
