Dear Parents and Carers

I hope you enjoyed a relaxing weekend.

Hampshire County Council have written to me this morning to advise me that they will be commencing work shortly to construct the next phase of the foot/cycle path through the woodland to the rear of our school, known as the Ennerdale Road Green Grid Green Loop (GGGL) Phase 4 scheme.

I have copied and pasted the detail for you below.

Phase 1 of the path was completed toward the end of last year, between Oakley Road and the rear gate of the school.

Phase 4 will deliver an extension of this route through the woodland, running north-west between Phase 1 (school rear entrance) through to the WBRC Parcel 3.8 development site land boundary (land between school boundary and Station Road).

Following completion of the HCC phase, the developer will be delivering the continuation of the facility through to Station Road during the build out of their development site, which I understand is due to commence later this year.

HCC's appointed contractor will commence Phase 4 works on 5 October 2020, with a programmed construction period of 5 weeks. Access to the construction site will be via the existing MoD access track from Station Road.

The works will be undertaken with supervision from HCC arboriculture and ecology teams. The contractor will take all required measures to maintain the security of their site and the Phase 4 works area will be fenced off at its connection to the Phase 1 path during construction.

Whilst for the most part the Phase 1 path will remain open, there is likely to be a short period of time where the Phase 1 path will need to be closed to allow the two paths to be joined. Signage will be placed on site with advance notice of this short period of closure when dates are programmed.
