I encourage you to read through the information pack thoroughly with your child so that you and your child become familiar with our routines and expectations. This will help your child quickly settle into life with us at Oakmoor School.

Your child has been placed in a mentor group and a House group as part of the Oakmoor School pastoral system. You will notice a sticker on the front of your pack detailing this information, including the name of your child's mentor. Your child will also be placed in a Year 7 class for learning and they will discover which class this will be in September, they will be placed with students from their mentor group.

The mentor will have daily contact with your child and will be a very important person during their secondary school life, being the main contact between home and school. We are very aware that your child may still have several questions about Oakmoor School, so your child's mentor will make contact with you over the next few weeks to introduce themselves, and to answer anything else you would like to know about Oakmoor School. We hope that a friendly conversation will help reassure you and your child, and will help to reduce any anxiousness about starting secondary school.
