Dear Parents and Carers

I am writing to provide some further information regarding our Year 6 Summer School.

As you may have already heard we are currently planning a two week summer school that will take place during the first two weeks of the summer term. The dates will run from Monday 26 July to Friday 6 August.

We would ask for your child to be dropped off at the front entrance of Oakmoor School at 9:00am each day. We will finish at 3:00pm. All children will receive a free lunch every day as part of our summer school, but you may wish to pack drinks and snacks for break times.

We are currently planning a wide range of activities that will span subjects from our curriculum, including English, mathematics, art and design, sport, performing arts, and in addition looking at including team building and communication exercises that will help our new students start to get to know each other a little better ahead of the start of term in September.

We will maintain our stringent infection control protocol and follow government guidelines regarding COVID-19 to ensure that we keep all children, staff and our wider community safe. We will have sanitizer on site, but will require children to wear a mask when inside the buildings and classroom.

We have applied for government funding to support running our summer school, which will mean that it will be free of charge to any families who wish for their child to attend. At this stage we need to ascertain how many children will attend so that I can arrange staffing for the two weeks.

If you would like to send your child to our summer school, please can I ask that you click the link below and complete the online form. Please can I ask that you have completed this by 4:00pm on Thursday 1 July 2021. If you indicate that you would like a place we will follow this letter with a medical form that we will require you to complete ahead of us being able to grant a place at summer school.
